Tiwanaku is considered one of the oldest civilizations of the Andean region (1300 BC - 1200 AD), standing out above the others for its brilliant cultural development and architectural, astronomical, religious knowledge, etc., which lasted around 3000 years, reaching to become the most important populated center of its time in South America.

The ruins of Tiwanaku are located at a distance of 72 km from the city of La Paz, its colossal constructions awaken the admiration of its visitors. Among the most outstanding archaeological remains are: The temple of Kalasasaya, the Pyramid of Akapana, the semi-subterranean Templete, the Puerta del Sol, the temple of Puma Punku The guided tour to Tiwanaku, begins with the pick up at the hotels at 08:30, then we headed to this archaeological site, arriving at 10:30; We make the visit to the museums and the ruins, it will last for 3 hours. Then we will enjoy lunch at a restaurant and then return to the city of La Paz, arriving at this city at 3:30 p.m.
